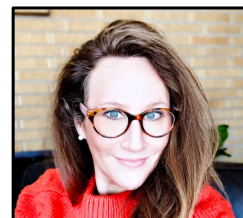

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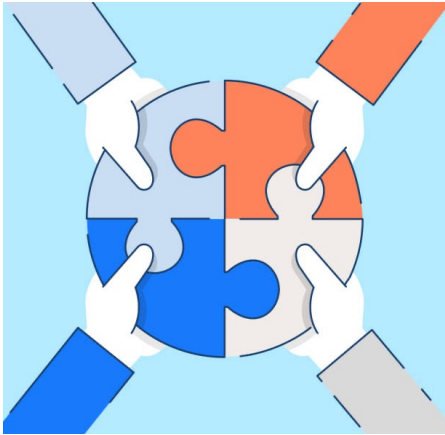
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## Overview of the CHIRP Program

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## Prioritizing a Trust Framework

MNCM is a long standing, trusted community collaborative.

Other existing data exchanges don't allow for multi-stakeholder convening and are costly.

MNCM emphasizes data integrity by facilitating multi-stakeholder engagement from the beginning.

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## **CHIRP** *Common Health Information Reporting Partnership*

The CHIRP program is established to **empower stakeholders with meaningful data** to drive **improvement in health care quality, equity, and affordability** by facilitating data sharing among health care payers and health care providers for specified use cases.

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## The Two CHIRP Data Standards

### Provider to Payer

- Goal: Medical groups could leverage the same PIPE standard to send specific data elements directly to the health plans.
- Medical groups go through NCQA Data Aggregator Validation Program

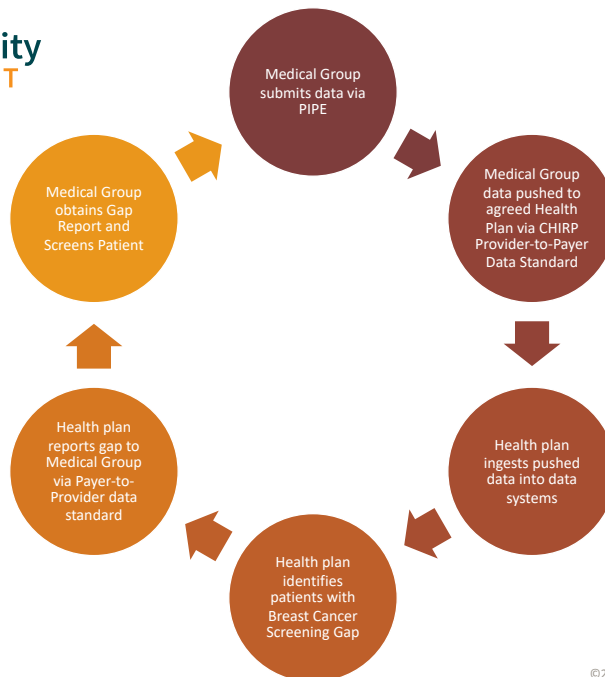
### Payer to Provider

- Goal: More timely exchange of information increases accuracy of identified potential “gap” and 1) reduces the chase 2) increases performance rates
- Standardizes and aggregates data and gap reports from various payers

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## CHIRP Feedback Loop Example



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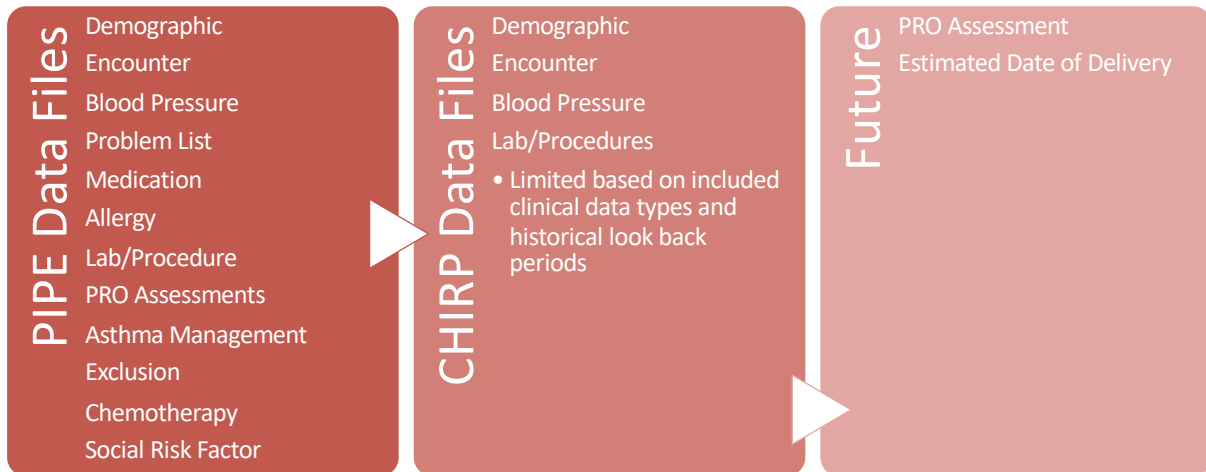
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## Accomplishments

- MNCM and four medical groups validated through NCQA Data Aggregator Validation Program
- Four participating Medical Groups and Three Health Plans
  - Automated data facilitation since March

## In Progress

    - Estimated Date of Delivery
    - Pregnancy Labs
  - PRO Assessment Data for depression screenings
