



Why submit Social Risk Factors?

Potential Uses of SRF Data

- Understand how risk factors affect outcomes (quality measures)
- Comparative information to identify "bright spots" and opportunities for improvement
- Potential use in risk adjustment of quality measures
- Potential use of MNCM data in value-based payment – incentives to close gaps

Evaluate Improvement


- Intervention strategies

Step One:


Evaluate Problem List and Encounters

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Historical vs. Incremental Files


Historical Data (Onboarding)

- Historical data starts 1/1/2019 and ends 12/31 of the previous year of onboarding. (e.g., 1/1/2019-12/31/2023).
- SRF: Includes those that were active on the patient record during the submission dates of service.

Incremental Data (Subsequent Submissions)

- Incremental data is based on Medical Group's preference for submitting data post-onboarding (e.g., monthly, quarterly, etc).
- SRF: Records that were active or updated on the patient record during the submission dates of service.
