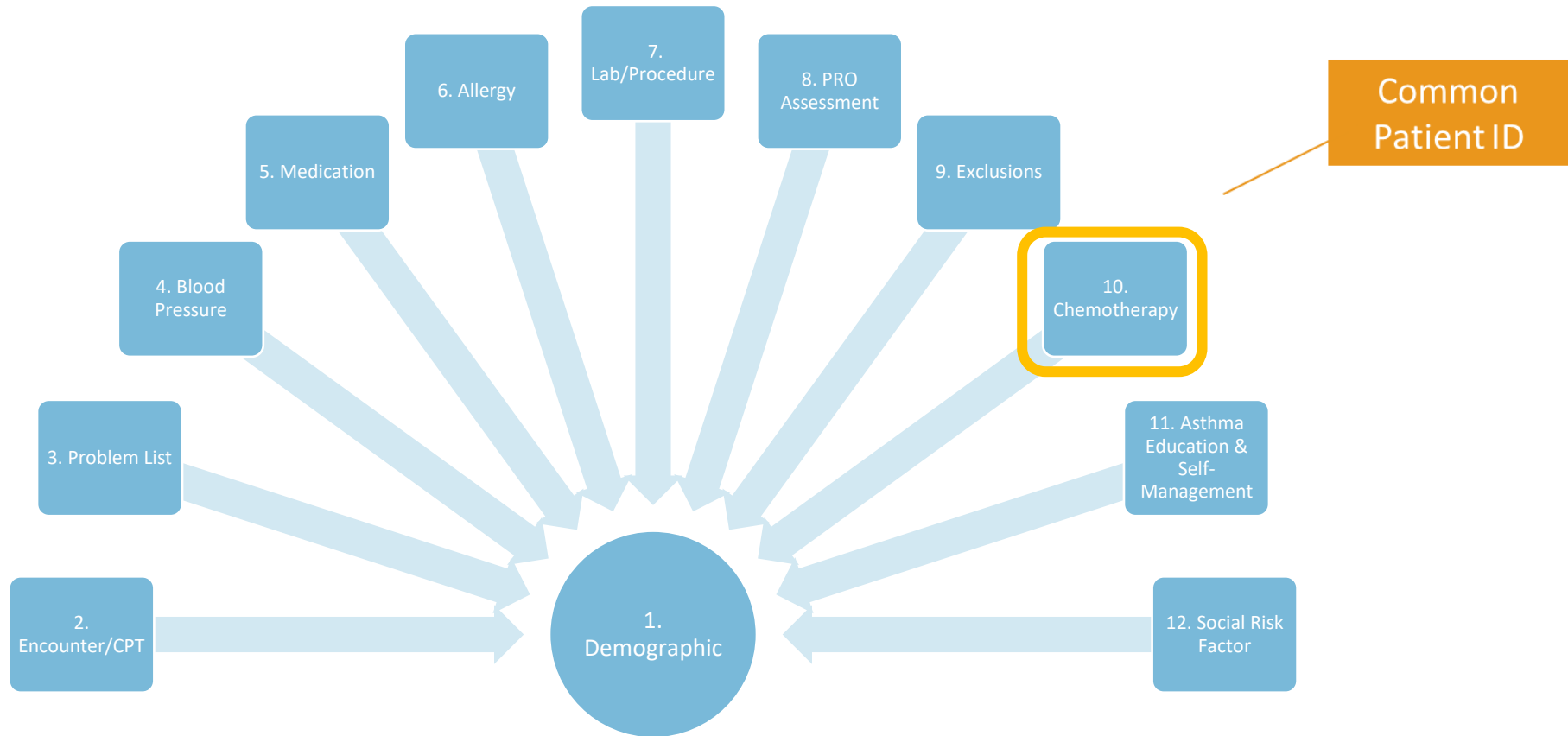


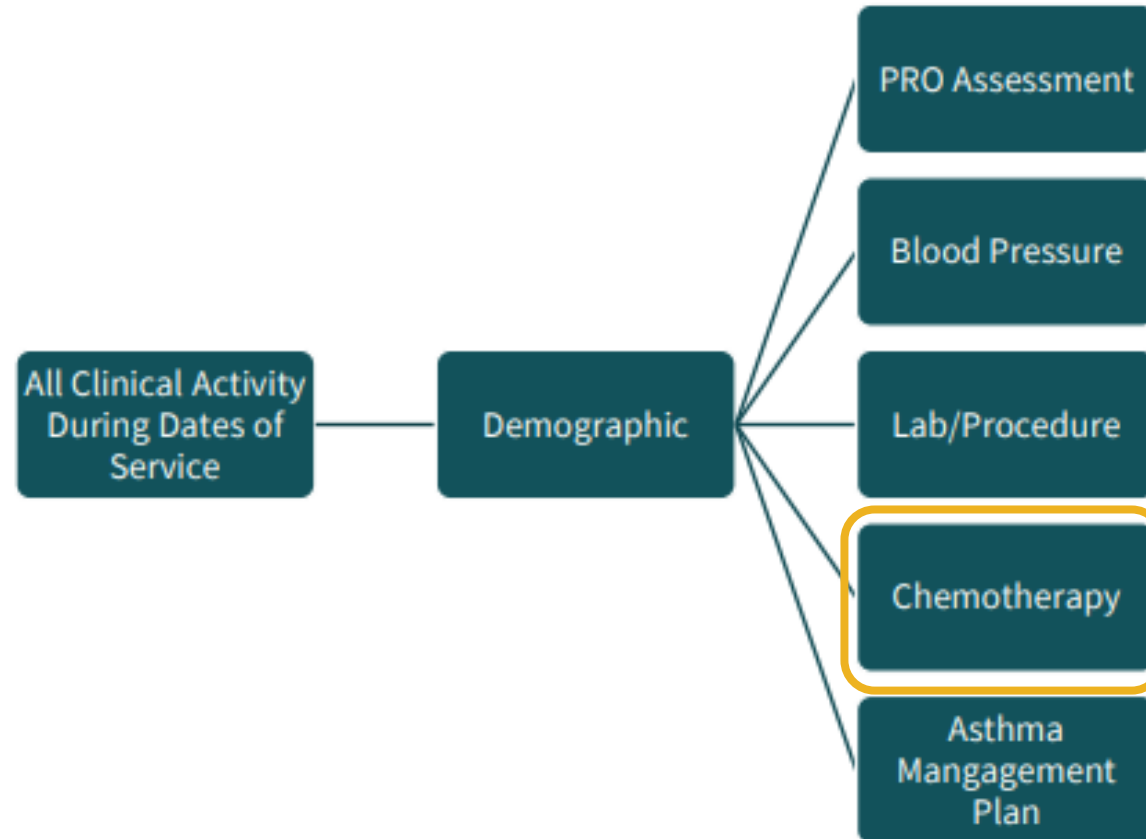

Chemotherapy Cycle Definitions

Field Name	Details	Required or Situational	Format/Field Length	Error causes
Cycle Number	The number of the cycle of chemotherapy and/or biologic immunotherapy within the treatment regimen	Required (R)	Number	Blank rows will cause errors.
Cycle Day 1 Date		Required (R)	mm/dd/yyyy or m/d/yyyy	

Field Name	Details	Required or Situational	Format/Field Length	Error causes
Clinic ID	MNCM ID of clinic where the administration of chemotherapy and/or biologic immunotherapy occurred on the date in Element Position 3.	Required	Number; up to 4 digits	Blank fields Values outside allowable range

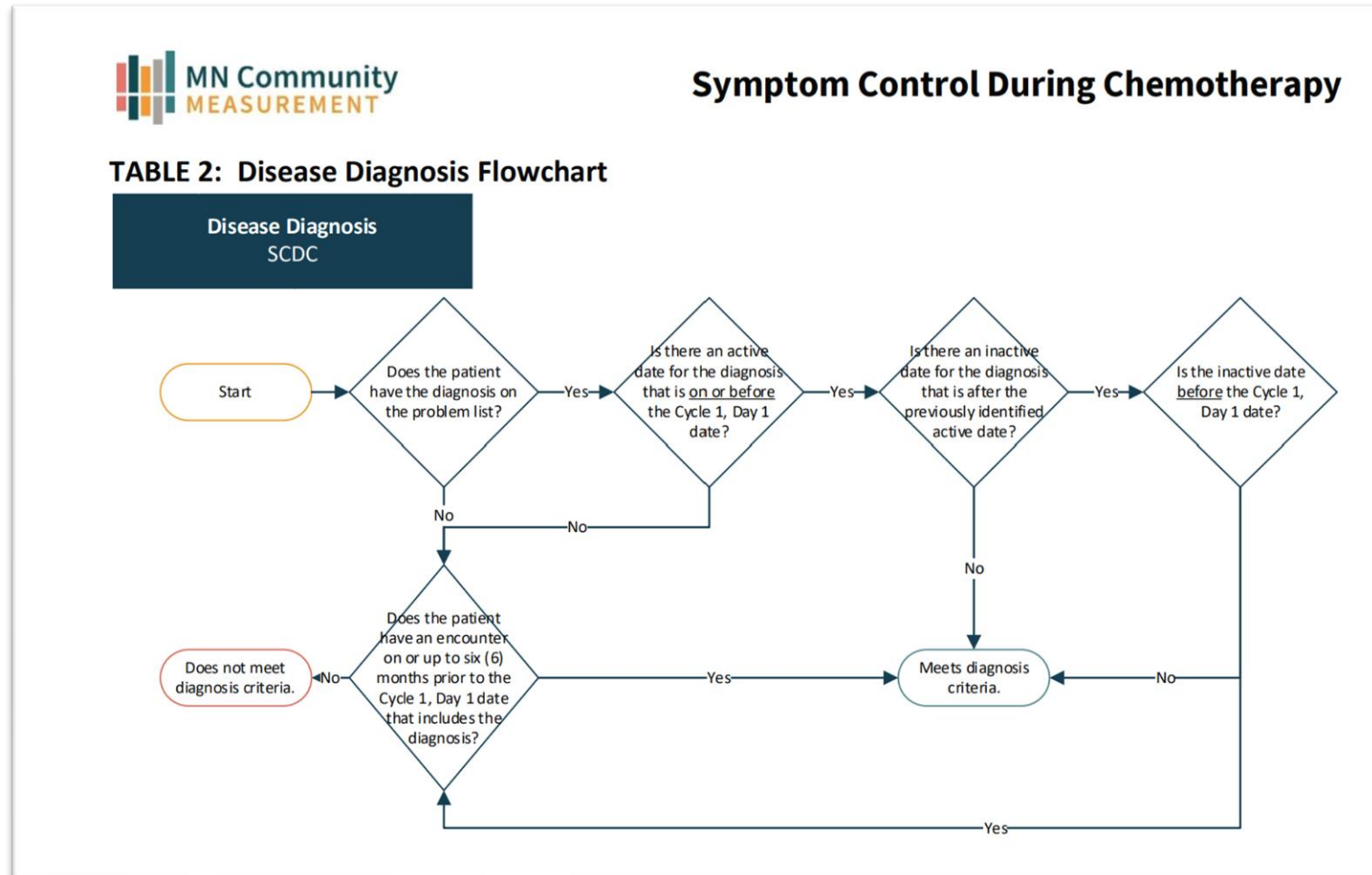
Treatment Intent

Field Name	Details	Required or Situational	Format/Field Length	Error causes
Treatment Intent	Enter the code that corresponds with the treatment intent at the start of the cycle. 1 = curative intent 2 = non-curative intent	Situational	Number; 1 digit	

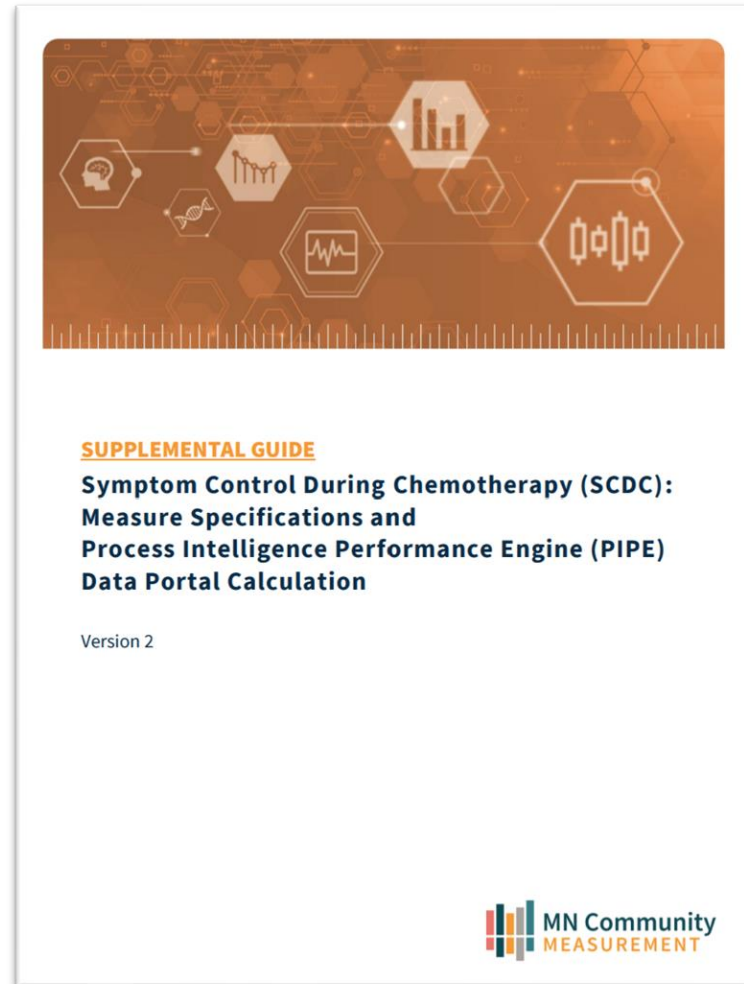
Other uses for chemotherapy & Immunotherapy

- Patients may receive chemotherapy or immunotherapy for diseases other than cancer.
- Autoimmune diseases that use chemotherapy and similar immunotherapy:
 - Scleroderma/ systemic sclerosis
 - Rheumatoid arthritis
 - Inflammatory bowel disease
 - Multiple sclerosis
 - Others

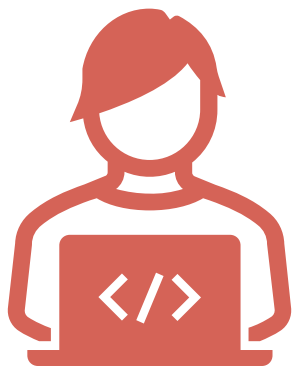
