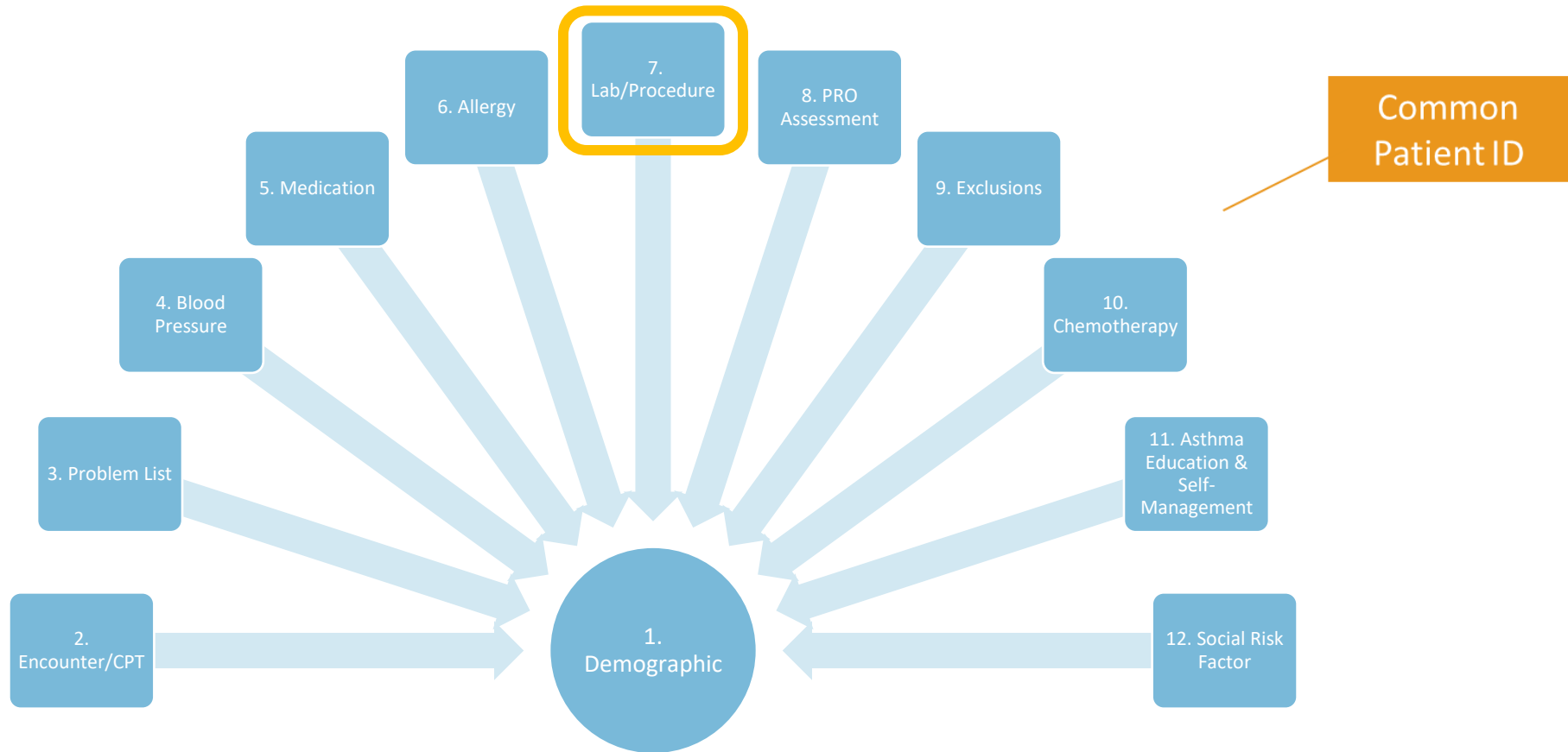


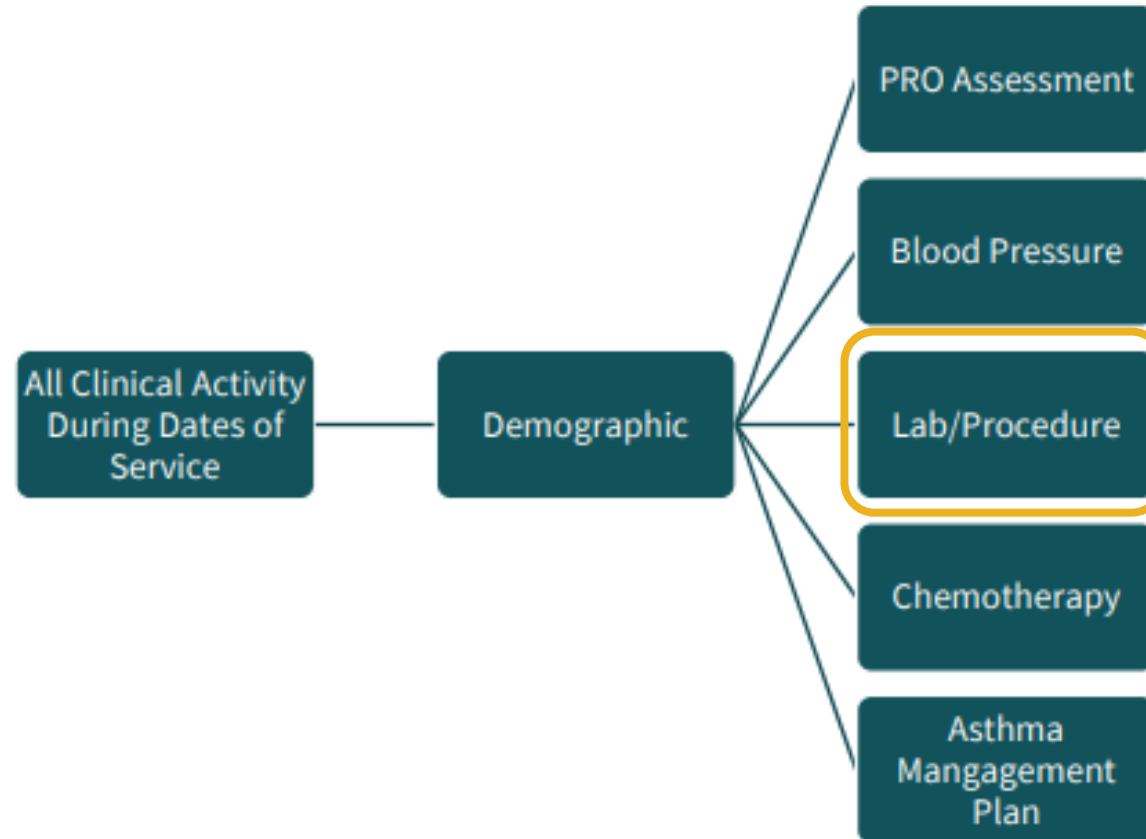

Lab Service Date	Enter the date that the lab was <u>performed</u> .	Situational	mm/dd/yyyy or m/d/yyyy	
Procedure Date	Enter the date that the procedure was <u>performed</u> .	Situational	mm/dd/yyyy or m/d/yyyy	

Field Name	Details	Required or Situational	Format/Field Length	Error causes
Lab Code	<p>Supply the codes for ALL labs performed by the submitting medical group and that are part of the patient record. This includes labs that are not currently associated with MNCM clinical quality measures.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Code types may include LOINC, CPT, and SNOMED. Because CPTs often represent bundled panel labs, LOINC is preferred.</li> <li>Submit <u>procedure</u> CPT codes in the Procedure Code field.</li> <li>If Lab Code is populated, leave Lab Type BLANK.</li> </ul>	Situational	String; up to 250 characters

- Lab codes and procedure codes should NOT be limited to only clinical quality data to minimize the need to update the query in the future.
- Include lookback periods every time patient is pulled into data file:
  - Colonoscopies: 10 years from start of submission period
  - LDLs, Sigmoidoscopies, and CT Colonography: 5 years from start of submission period
  - FIT-DNA tests: 3 years from start of submission period
- Pull lab results exactly as they are documented in patient record (i.e., numeric, text, etc.)
- Knee Replacement Laterality
  - Indicate which knee was replaced (if documented)
  - Sequential procedures are treated as two separate procedures
  - Leave blank if patient had bilateral procedure

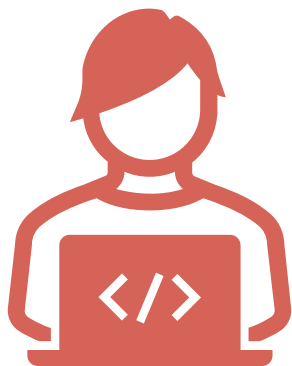
